Group thinking around: low wages + lack of diversity programming

- MIKE-Thinking about this through the lens of CAPACITY BUILDING
 - Increasing salaries, improving jobs, growing the field
 - Maybe this should be a full day workshop
 - Maybe having NAAEE involved as a first step?
 - Federal commitment is too low and is related to capacity building
- BETHANY- Thinking about temporary & seasonal positions vs full time jobs and careers.
 - Massive turnover
 - o Incorporating an action plan-tips & tricks to have convos with boards & ED's, letter writing skills
- JADE- Advertising Job Postings
 - Other groups require listed salaries to post in their listservs
 - Could EEAC encourage/require orgs to share salaries when they post?
 - Include timelines and other important information
 - We should encourage NAAEE to do the same!
- SUNNY-SYEP
 - Have DYCD present about internships (summer & school year)
 - This could be a way to help get more young people interested in a career in environmental education
- FRAN-Themes
 - BIG PICTURE/STEPS: policy & funding
 - SMALL STEPS: Best practices we can take right away, how to empower individuals part of large orgs, encouraging orgs to post wages, creating career pathways
 - Event structure- Is this a panel?

Group thinking around: low wages + lack of diversity programming

- FRAN-Structure Ideas for the Event- how do these ideas populate into a day of activity
 - Could be a conference with multiple breakout rooms so people can pick and choose what would be most helpful to them
 - o 1 day conference?

 - DYCD Presentation on SYEP & other Internships
 - ADVOCACY to grow the field-increase federal funding
 - ACTION STEPS FOR ORGS Small action steps people can take
 - HIRING BEST PRACTICES?
 - PGM People of Global Majority- creating a safe space for Black people to come together. Could try to find a speaker to address this.
 - MENTORSHIP- Action approach for mentorship. Some way for people established in their career connect with younger environmental education professionals. Get some training.
